



In 2026, the financial landscape of New Zealand's pest management remains heavily skewed towards lethal methods. While the government disestablished [Predator Free 2050 Limited](#) in late 2025 as a cost-saving measure, the [Department of Conservation \(DOC\)](#) has absorbed its functions, continuing the "moonshot" goal of total eradication.

The "Follow the Money" Snapshot (2025/26)

The Economic "Pest" Narrative

The [DOC](#) frames this spend as an investment in the economy, estimating the cost of animal pests and weeds at roughly **\$840 million a year** (approx. 1% of GDP). This massive figure is used to justify the \$3.6 million in annual savings from closing PF2050 Ltd and consolidating it into the more "efficient" bureaucratic structure of DOC.

Why "Stability" is a Political Threat

If the "Unwilding" mission were successful, it would prove that:

- **Aerial 1080 (costing \$18–\$42/ha)** is not the only way to protect birds.
- **Ground Control (costing \$10–\$26/ha)** could be replaced by community-led guardianship that doesn't require annual repetition of killing.
- **The "Pest" Economy** is self-perpetuating; if the cats provide a [Sentinel Shield](#) that stops the rats, the "need" for million-dollar annual toxin contracts vanishes.
