Subject: FORMAL OBJECTION: Data Integrity & Forensic Omissions in PF2050 Strategy (2026)

Tēnā koutou,

I am writing to formally record my **objection** to the upcoming March 2026 Predator Free 2050 implementation. I submit the attached **SGL Master Audit Index [Ref: Document 21]** as formal evidence of significant forensic and scientific inaccuracies in the current policy.

My specific concerns include:

- **Forensic Omissions:** The identified **93.1% evidence gap** in foundational predation reports, specifically regarding the 1994 Rangataua bat mortality data [Ref: SG-BAT-001].
- **The Rat Surge Risk:** The failure to account for **Mesopredator Release** following feline removal, leading to unmanaged rodent population spikes [Ref: SG-RAT-005].
- **Legal Sentience:** The conflict between proposed lethal methods (including aerial 1080) and the **Animal Welfare Act 1999**, which recognizes all animals as sentient beings.

I request a formal acknowledgement of receipt for this submission and the attached forensic research. I look forward to your response regarding how these data integrity issues will be resolved before the 2026 rollout.
